She was studying early music and attended master classes with Prof. Stembridge (in Ukraine, Germany and Italy). She attended master classes with Prof. Peretti, Essl, Zerer, Preston, Christy, Rampe, Joseph, Roth.

Laureate of many international organ and music festivals.

The winner of the Third international competition of organists of V. Kikta in Moscow (2008).

In 1998-2013 Natalia worked as a soloist at the Dnepropetrovsk Organ and Chamber Music Hall (Ukraine). Natalia is awarded the medal "For contribution to the development of the Dnipropetrovsk region" (2012).

She is also an award winner of the Belcanto Foundation of the Lutheran Church of St. Paul and St. Peter located in city of Moscow.
